

You want to be a change maker and mobilise people across Europe for fair and ecological food and farming? You have experience in project implementation and are a good networker? If so, you should apply with the **European campaign Good Food Good Farming.** We push for a sustainable food and farming transition together with a broad alliance of civil society organisations.

Good Food Good Farming mobilises people and organisations to participate in campaigning activities for fairer and greener food and farming policies in the European Union, including the annual days of action every October. Our goal is to empower citizens across Europe to hold their governments and EU institutions accountable for policies, which are destroying the future of farming and the planet. The campaign is hosted by the German alliance for nature conservation, Deutscher Naturschutzring (DNR e.V.) in Berlin.

We look for a new 'project and network manager' to start on 1 April 2022 (25-30h/week).

Your main tasks will be to:

- Support the planning of the work programme and take on responsibility for implementation of defined activities, including the co-ordination of collaborative pesticide testing
- Monitor the project timeline and activities, and collate evidence and feedback
- Administrate the project budget, funding applications and reports
- Organise exchange meetings and administer email lists with partners at national and EU level, including partner organisations, farmers organisations and activists
- Assist in the moderation of the campaign's steering group and provide regular updates
- Update and maintain the website of the campaign (www.gfgf.eu)
- Work closely together with the campaign coordinator in the GFGF team

You are the right one for this job, if you...

- Have experience in managing projects, incl. fundraising and budget management (preferably 2 years)
- Are a good networker, who can bring people together and motivate them to cooperate
- Have a structured way of thinking and working, can keep the overview of complex projects and cope with stressful situations
- Are enthusiastic to co-ordinate a diverse pan-European network
- Speak fluent English and basic German, other European languages are a bonus
- Basic knowledge about EU food and farming politics or campaigning are a plus, but not required

What we offer:

- Working in a motivated, European Team with people who aim to have long standing impact on food and farming
- Get deeper insight into the campaign work of NGOs in various EU countries
- Part-time contract (25-30h per week) for one year, until 31 March 2023
- Remuneration: approximately 2,600 Euros (before taxes) for 30h/week, based on experience
- Shared office in Berlin (central), with the option for remote working some days per week
